Robin Hopper is an internationally known potter, teacher, author, garden designer and arts activist. He has taught throughout Canada, and in England, U.S.A., Australia, New Zealand, China, Korea, Japan and Israel. His ceramic work is in public, corporate and private collections throughout the world. He was born in England in 1939, and trained there at Croydon College of Art (1956-1961). He has developed studios in both England and Canada, where he immigrated in 1968. After two years teaching in Toronto at Central Technical School, he set up and headed the Ceramics and Glass Department at Georgian College, Barrie, Ontario. In 1972 he resigned from teaching to devote full energies to his work in ceramics. 1977 included relocation to Victoria, B.C., Canada, and becoming the first recipient of the **Bronfman Award**, Canada's most prestigious annual award in the crafts. He is the author of "The Ceramic Spectrum", "Functional Pottery", "Staying Alive", "Making Marks", a new edition of Daniel Rhodes' "Clay and Glazes for the Potter", and his autobiography, "Robin Hopper Ceramics".
